NOTICE - CHALLENGE MECHANISM**

1. Refer to INCET-01/2025 advertisement published in Employment News dated 05-11 Jul 25 and 20-26 Sep 25 of which examination/ re-examination was held on 31 Aug - 03 Sep 25 and on 02 Feb 26.
2. The 'Challenge Mechanism' portal link will be available at landing page to view Master question paper, View QP, indicative answer key and questions to be cancelled/ deleted to challenge/ raise objections in Master question paper, if any, through www.joinindiannavy.gov.in >> **Join Navy** >> **Ways to join** >> **Civilians** >> **INCET-01/2025**. Candidates are advised to carefully go through the promulgated guidelines before raising challenge/ objections.
3. **Timelines.** Opening/ Closing timelines of 'Challenge Mechanism' Portal are as follows:-
 - 3.1. Opening - 1030 hrs on 29 May 2026.
 - 3.2. Closing - 2359 hrs on 11 June 2026.
4. **Fee.** The prescribed fee for raising the objections is Rs 100/- plus applicable bank service charges per question. In case the objection raised is found to be correct, the fee paid against such valid objections shall be refunded to the candidates after deduction of applicable bank charges. However, no fee will be charged against the indicative cancelled/ deleted questions.
5. Candidates are advised to raise objection(s), if any, well within the prescribed timelines. Thereafter, no representation from the candidates received through any other modes viz letter, application, e-mail etc will be entertained. No individual candidate will be informed about the acceptance/ non-acceptance of his/ her challenge.
6. Challenges made by the candidates will be verified by the panel of subject matter experts and, if found correct, the answer key will be revised/ finalised and result prepared accordingly.
7. The decision of Indian Navy on the objections raised shall be final and binding, and no further correspondence will be entertained from the candidates.
